I am a member of Advocacy and Caring for Children (ACC), supporting our 22nd annual Labor of Love auction. Advocacy and Caring for Children (ACC) is a group of committed women who support a network of programs focused on the needs of underserved children and families in an effort to improve their quality of life. For over 100 years, ACC members have remained faithful to the needs of children and families by providing financial and volunteer resources through steadfast partnerships with organizations across Western Washington. Founded in 1918, we continue to be an important part of women's and children's lives.

Our Labor of Love auction proceeds help us fulfill grant requests. ACC granted \$215,000 to 23 agencies during the fiscal year, 2023-2024.

- ACC grants funds semi-annually through a formal grant application process.
- Network of programs that are recipient of ACC grants include: Youth Tutoring Program, Pregnancy and Parenting Support, Sacred Heart Shelter, Adoption Services King County, CCS Child and Family Counseling, Emergency Assistance CCS King & South King County.
- Total served by category 2023-2024:

Children and Families: 1,150: 1.45% of served : \$62,500 : 29.07% of grants funded

Education and Emergency Services: 22,645 : 28.59% : \$84,500 : 39.31% of grants funded

Adoption and Immigration: 102: .13% : \$20,000 : 9.3% of grants funded

Infant Care - Specialty Services: 6,592: 8.32% : \$28,000 : 13.02% of grants funded

Meals: 648,729: 61.51% : \$20,000 : 9.3 % of grants funded

Our goal is to fund all grants requested at 100% this fall. With your donation support, we will be able to help these kids!
